

# The Garden of Creativity & Inspired Becoming

Begin by finding a comfortable position.

Allow your body to settle into the support beneath you.

Let your spine lengthen gently, but without strain.

or place them softly over your heart or belly.

When you are ready, close your eyes.

and release it gently through your mouth.

There is nothing you need to fix.

Nothing you need to force.

Bring your awareness now to your breath.

Notice the gentle rise and fall of your chest.

Each inhale brings fresh possibility.

Each exhale releases tension and expectation.

Imagine that with every breath in, you are drawing in inspiration—

light, playful, and full of potential.

With every breath out, release doubt...

release pressure...

release the idea that creativity must be perfect.

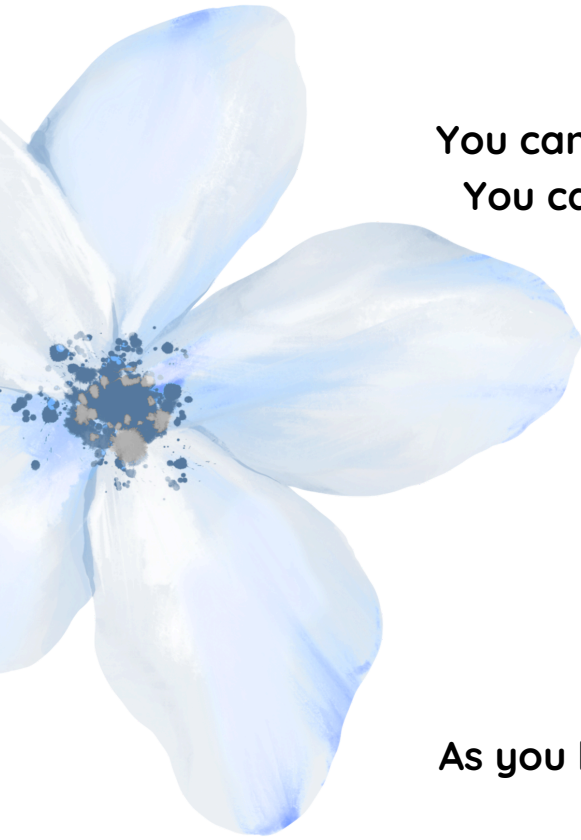
Creativity begins with curiosity.

Your ideas.**

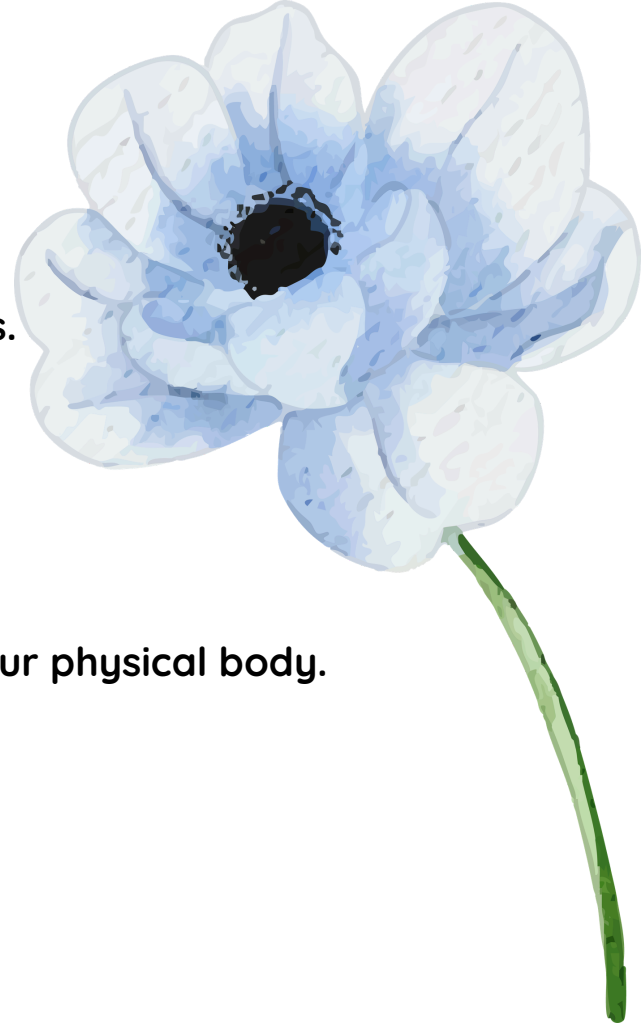
Your dreams.
